1. There will be one (1) boys' game and one (1) girls' game.

2. Each team will consist of fifteen (15) players as voted upon by the varsity head coaches or their representatives.

3. Each school may nominate up to five (5) senior players. Consideration should be given to the fact that the more players nominated, the more it will split the votes. **Players should be of true all-star caliber.**

4. **CLASS ROUND:** An initial ballot will be given to all coaches. This ballot will list all nominations alphabetically by state and by classification. [See classification of schools.] With this ballot, coaches are to vote only for players in their class. One (1) player will be selected from each class in Ohio. In West Virginia, one (1) player will be selected from 1A, 2A, 3A-4A, and 5A. Coaches may not vote for their own players in this round.

5. **LOTTERY ROUND:** After these players are selected, their names will be removed from the master ballot, and the second ballot will be voted. Coaches will then vote for the remaining players, regardless of class (Ohio will select ten; West Virginia will select eleven. Time should be given prior to the voting for any coach to speak on behalf of his players and for coaches to discuss the type of player needed to round out their squad.

6. The next five (5) highest vote getters in the lottery round of voting will comprise an alternate pool. In the event that one of the fifteen players does not play in the game, the director will select a player from the pool to fill the vacancy.

7. When coaches submit their nominations, they will be asked to vote for one (1) coach from their state who they feel deserves the honor of coaching in the game. These coaches will be contacted as to their availability and placed on a ballot. The highest vote getter will be the head coach, with the second and third place vote getters becoming assistants.
