

OVAC RUDY MUMLEY ALL-STAR FOOTBALL CLASSIC

Effective 2011 - 2012

1. The method of selecting the coaches for the All-Star game shall remain as it has in the past, with the highest ranking coach from each state coaching the game for the class whose turn it is. The rotation is as follows:

1A	2012	2017	2022	2027	2032	2037
2A	2013	2018	2023	2028	2033	2038
3A	2014	2019	2024	2029	2034	2039

5A	2016	2021	2026	2031	2036	2041

The head coach will select his staff. Although it will probably be his staff, he is not limited in his selection, and may ask any coach from any class in his state.

The coaching staff shall consist of no more than eight (8) coaches. These coaches are expected to be varsity coaches and/or varsity assistants and not junior high coaches. Should a school not have eight coaches and desires to add more, they may utilize coaches from other schools within their state (and the Conference) with the approval of the game director. The Conference provides certified trainers for both sides, so these are not needed. NO EXCEPTIONS to this rule are to be made, including Evening with the Stars, camp, and game day. (12.26.08)

Should a coach in the selected class decline coaching in the game, the next highest ranking coach will be asked. Should there be no coach available in that class, the committee will go to the class who coached the previous year and make the selection.

2. In selecting the players, the coach must follow the following guidelines:

Thirty-two (32) players **plus** a kicker will be selected from each state.

No more than three (3) players may be selected from any Ohio school.

No more than three (3) players may be selected from any West Virginia school.

The coach may select one (1) bonus player from two (2) schools. Therefore, TWO Ohio schools may have four (4) players, and TWO West Virginia schools may have five (4) players.

3. The kicker may be from any school and does not count in the above totals. However, the kicker **CAN ONLY KICK** in the game and not play any other offensive or defensive position. Should he play an offensive or defensive position, the coach may only select thirty-two (32) players.

4. Not every school in the Conference has to have a player in the game. However, coaches are urged to try to incorporate players from as many schools as possible. A rule of thumb would be representing 80% of the schools in West Virginia and 70% of the schools in Ohio **who nominate players for the game.**
